WHAT IS THE ORDER OF DE MOLAY?

The Order of DeMolay is a fraternal organization which offers to each qualified youth from twelve to twenty years of age inclusive, (1) a wholesome occupation of his spare time, (2) worthwhile associates, (3) the best of environment and (4) an interesting and complete program of all-around youth development.

HOW DOES DE MOLAY OPERATE?

There are more than 1,000 chapters worldwide. They are located in various cities in the United States and foreign countries. Each chapter is run by its own members and each of these chapters has an advisory board that goes through training known as the D.A.D training (DeMolay Advisor Development.)

Extensive and strict background checks are administered by DeMolay International Headquarters for the safety of the members of new advisors, and yes, some chapters even have chapter moms. But the advisors only step in when needed to help the chapter at certain times and make sure everything goes as smooth as possible.

WHO MAY BECOME MEMBERS OF THE ORDER OF DE MOLAY?

Any youth who has passed his twelfth (12) birthday and not reached his twenty-first (21) birthday and is of good character may petition a DeMolay chapter for membership. IT IS NOT NECESSARY THAT HE BE A SON OR A RELATIVE OF A MASON.

IS DE MOLAY A RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION? A FRATERNITY? A SECRET ORDER?

DeMolay does not recognize or advocate any particular creed but teaches only a profound faith in the one living and true God. Reverence for Sacred Things is one of the Order's Seven Cardinal Virtues. DeMolay is not a Greek letter fraternity and should not be confused with either high school or college fraternities. The Order of DeMolay has its secret signs, words, modes of recognition, etc., but it has no secrets from the world in so far as its central purpose is concerned.

WHAT TYPE OF INITIATION IS USED IN DE MOLAY?

The initiation of a member into the Order of DeMolay consists of the conferring of two very impressive degrees, the Initiatory Degree and the DeMolay Degree. The foundation upon which the Initiatory Degree is built is that of the Seven Cardinal Virtues of the Order. They are: Filial Love (Love of Parents), Reverence for Sacred Things, Courtesy, Comradeship, Fidelity, Cleanliness, and Patriotism. The DeMolay Degree is historical and spectacular and is presented in dramatic form. Its portrayal of the trials, tortures and final martyrdom of the exemplar of the Order, Jacques DeMolay, teaches a compelling lesson in fidelity and comradeship.

WHAT IS DE MOLAY'S PROGRAM OF ALL-AROUND YOUTH DEVELOPMENT?

The Order of DeMolay expects its members to attain a high-grade all-around youth development in preparation for the opportunities and responsibilities of manhood and aids them in this accomplishment. One of the highest distinctions a DeMolay can receive from DeMolay International is to be made a Representative DeMolay. This honor was created to recognize the achievements of any DeMolay who has made himself an all-around young man. The awarding of this honor is based on the following Seventeen Standards of Development --- Education; Reading; Self Expression; Current History; Nature Interests; Life Work; Health Education; Care of the Body; Physical Activities; Physical Fitness; Manual Skill; Home Relationships; Religious Ideals; Recreational Habits; Chapter Loyalty; Self Mastery; Citizenship.

Give youth the opportunity of having better associates for he is powerfully influenced by companions' ideas, beliefs and moral codes.

WHAT ARE THE SOCIAL ACTIVITIES IN DE MOLAY?

Such social activities are conducted by the chapters as are advisable under local conditions, all functions, however, being supervised by the adult Advisor of the chapter. In addition to locally planned activities, it is compulsory that the chapter observe annually the following Obligatory Days---Devotional Day; Patriots' Day; DeMolay Day of Comfort; Educational Day; and Parents' Day.
